

EARLY VOTING NOTICE

Consolidated Election – April 2, 2019

Connie Simmons, Jefferson County Clerk & Recorder, announces Early Voting requirements:

“Early Voting” will begin on Thursday, February 21, 2019, and end on Monday, April 1, 2019. Early Voting will only be available at our temporary polling place, County Clerk’s Annex Office, 100 South 10th Street, Room 105A, Mt. Vernon, Illinois, from 8 a.m. until 4:15 p.m., Monday thru Friday (except holidays), and on Saturdays, March 23, 2019, and March 30, 2019, from 8 a.m. until 12 noon.

State Law does not require photo identification for voting; however, if the signature does not match you may be required to furnish identification. Early voters are not required to offer a reason for voting prior to Election Day.

The Law prohibits anyone who votes during the Early Voting Period from also voting at the polls on Election Day. Early Voted ballots will be counted after the polls close on Election Day.
