Write-in Candidate

The last day to file a notarized Intent to be a Write-In Candidate is September 3, 2020.
(Form available on county web site or in our office.)

Register to Vote

The last day to register to vote or report a name or address change in office, State agency or with a Deputy Registrar and vote at your polling place is October 6, 2020.

Early Vote and Mail out ballots

The first day to Early Vote at the Courthouse or for a requested ballot to be mailed is September 24, 2020 (if ballots available). A signed application is required for a mail out ballot and they are available on the County web site or in our office.

Senior Citizens, Nursing Home Residents and Disabled Voters

Under the Federal Voting Accessibility for the Elderly and Handicapped Act, assistance for the elderly and disabled voters is available through the Jefferson County Clerk's Office. Jefferson County has accessible ballot marking machines called AutoMarks at all polling places and at the Courthouse Early Voting site, or disabled voters can request assistance by signing an affidavit.

Nursing Home absentee voting for the General Election, will be held on Friday, October 30, 2020, for all voters whom are registered to vote at such facility and a signed A-6 Application has been returned by noon on October 29, 2020. (Contact the Social Service/Activity Director at the Nursing Home for more information.) Nursing Home residents may also vote by mail for their convenience with or without signed assistance from family or staff. The Nursing Home will also be mailed applications for a mailed ballot (A-7) or they are available on the County web site or in our office.
