Notice is hereby given that on **April 6, 2021**, the following public questions, **will be submitted to the voters of the following named political subdivisions, as hereinafter set forth, which election will be open at 6:00 a.m. and continued until 7:00 p.m. of that day.**

To the voters of **Field Community Consolidated School District Number 3** will be submitted the following proposition:

Proposition to Issue \$2,600,000 School Building Bonds

Shall the Board of Education of Field Community School District Number 3, Jefferson County, Illinois, alter, repair, renovate and equip the existing facilities of the District, including but not limited to roof replacement, lighting replacement, electrical upgrades, restroom repairs and gym renovations, make site improvements and issue bonds of said School District to the amount of \$2,600,000 for the purpose of paying the costs thereof?
