

## **Primary Election – March 18, 2014**

Last day to file a notarized intent to be a **write-in** candidate – January 16, 2014

Last day to **register to vote or report address change** and vote at polling place\* –  
February 18, 2014

*All in person absentee and early absentee voters must have photo identification, and cannot retract their ballot and later vote in the polling place.*

**In Person absentee** – February 6, 2014 (if ballot programming received and testing complete), thru March 17, 2014

Monday thru Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. except holidays.

**Early Voting** – March 3, 2014, thru March 15, 2014

Monday thru Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m.

Saturdays March 8<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. until noon

**\*Grace Registration/Voting** – February 19, 2014, thru March 15, 2014

Register/Change and vote then – photo identification and address proof required.

Monday thru Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m.

Saturdays March 8<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. until 11:45 a.m.

**Mail Out absentee** – February 6, 2014, thru March 13, 2014

Complete and return an A-7 application (available on our web site.)

Mailed ballot (postage required) must be returned last  
post mark of March 17, 2014, and received by April 1, 2014.

**Nursing Home voting** – Friday, March 14, 2014

Resident must be registered in precinct where the Nursing Home is located to qualify for in person voting, and a signed A-6 application must be returned by noon on March 13, 2014. Residents may also vote by mail by signing an A-7 application (available on our web site). Contact the Nursing Home Social Service Director for information/application.
