ABSENTEE VOTING NOTICE
General Election – November 3, 2020

Voters must wear a mask, and are encouraged to bring their own pen. Social distancing will be enforced.

Early Voting at our temporary polling place, the County Clerk's Annex Office, 100 South 10th Street, Room 105A, Mt. Vernon, Illinois, will begin Thursday, September 24, 2020, and continue until Monday, November 2, 2020, from 8:15 a.m. until 4:15 p.m., Monday thru Friday, except October 12th (holiday), plus Saturdays, October 24 and 31st from 8:00 a.m. until noon, and Election Day November 3, 2020, from 6:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. (Hours may be extended depending on demand.)

Grace Registration and Voting will begin on October 7, 2020, thru November 2, 2020, Monday thru Friday, 8 a.m. until 4:15 p.m. except October 12th (holiday), and Saturdays, October 24th & 31st from 8 a.m. until noon, and Election Day November 3, 2020, from 6 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. Residents may register or change their registration with two forms of identification proving legal name, date of birth and current physical address, and after the registration process is complete, they must vote immediately in the Election Annex Office.

Illinois State Law prohibits anyone whom votes absentee from also voting at the polls in person on Election Day, unless the absentee ballot is surrendered to the Election Judges.

All early voted ballots will be processed prior to and on Election Day, but will not be counted until after the polls close on Election Day.
