

## Information for the General Election – November 4, 2014

Last day to file a notarized intent to be a **write-in** candidate is September 4, 2014.

Last day to **register to vote or report address change** and vote at your polling place is October 7, 2014.

**Grace Registration/Voting** – October 8, 2014 thru Election Day November 4, 2014

Register/Change and vote then\* – photo identification and address proof required.

Monday thru Friday, 8 a.m. until 4:30 p.m., except Election Day 6:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m., and Saturdays, October 25<sup>th</sup> and November 1<sup>st</sup> from 8 a.m. until 12 noon.

\*Nov. 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> registrants/voters – ballots will be sealed until voter registration card can be mailed, and ballot will be counted with late arriving ballots on November 18th.

**In Person Absentee** – September 25, 2014 (if ballot programming received and testing complete) thru November 3, 2014, Monday thru Friday except holidays from 8 a.m. until 4:30 p.m.

**Early Voting** – October 20, 2014, thru November 1, 2014

Monday thru Friday from 8 a.m. until 4:30 p.m., and Saturdays, October 25<sup>th</sup> and November 1<sup>st</sup> from 8 a.m. until 12 noon. State Law has changed no longer requiring photo identification for Early Voting; however, if signature does not match, you will be required to furnish identification.

**Mail Out Absentee** – Applications can be returned starting August 6, 2014 thru October 30, 2014.

Ballots will not be mailed out until approximately September 25, 2014. Complete and return an A-7 application (available on our web site or call my office). Returned mailed ballot (postage required) must be postmarked by November 3, 2014, and received by November 18, 2014.

**Nursing Home Voting** – Friday, October 31, 2014

Nursing Home residents who are registered to vote at such facility are the only voters who may participate in the in-person absentee voting at the nursing home, and a signed A-6 application must be returned by noon on October 30, 2014, from the Social Service Director at the Nursing Home. Residents may also vote by mail by signing an A-7 application. Contact the Social Service Director at the Nursing Home for information and/or application.

All in person absentee, early absentee, and grace registrants/voters cannot retract their absentee ballot and later vote in their polling place. (Certain circumstances such as non-receipt might void a mailed ballot with County Clerk approval.)
