ABSENTEE VOTING NOTICE
General Primary Election - March 17, 2020

Early Voting at our temporary polling place, the County Clerk's Annex Office, 100 South 10th Street, Room 105A, Mt. Vernon, Illinois, will begin Thursday, February 6, 2020, and continue until Monday, March 16, 2020, from 8:00 a.m. until 4:15 p.m., Monday thru Friday, except holidays February 12th & 17th, plus Saturdays, March 7th and 14th from 8:00 a.m. until noon.

Grace Registration and Voting will begin on February 19, 2020, thru Election day, Monday thru Friday, 8 a.m. until 4:15 p.m. except holidays February 12th & 17th, and Saturdays, March 7th & 14th from 8 a.m. until noon. Residents may register or change their registration with two forms of identification proving legal name, date of birth and current physical address, and after the registration process is completed vote immediately in the Election Annex Office.

Illinois State Law prohibits anyone whom votes absentee from also voting at the polls in person on Election Day, unless the absentee ballot is surrendered to the Election Judges.

All early voted ballots will be processed prior to and on Election Day, but will not be counted until after the polls close on Election Day.
