Nursing Home in-person absentee voting for the November 6, 2018, General Election will be held on Friday, November 2, 2018, for all residents whom are registered to vote at such facility, and a signed A-6 Application has been returned by the Social Service Director of the Nursing Home. Residents may also vote by mail by signing an A-7 Application (available on web site or call my office), and returning to County Clerk's Office between August 8, 2018, and November 1, 2018. (Mailed ballots may be completed at resident's convenience with signed assistance from family or staff, and return postmark by Election Day. Postage is required on all mail returned ballots.) Contact the Social Service Director at the Nursing Home for either application.
