

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-02

AN ORDINANCE BY THE JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD ADOPTING THE SALARY SCHEDULE FOR JEFFERSON COUNTY STATE'S ATTORNEY AND CORONER

WHEREAS, County Boards have the authority to set salaries and/or per diem of County Election Officials within the guidelines set forth in the Illinois revised statutes; and

WHEREAS, salaries and/or per diem for such election officials must be set before the date the elected official assumes the duties of the office; now,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF JEFFERSON COUNTY, ILLINOIS THAT THE SALARY SCHEDULE BE SET FOR THE FOLLOWING OFFICIALS:

STATE'S ATTORNEY

Shall be set according to state law and not by County Board action.

CORONER

Shall be set forth below:

Salary effective 12/1/20 shall be \$36,544.16 (no increase)

Salary effective 12/1/21 shall be \$36,909.60 (1% increase)

Salary effective 12/1/22 shall be \$37,647.79 (2% increase)


Salary effective 12/1/23 shall be \$38,400.75 (2% increase)

Also, the Office Holders will pay \$60.00 per month toward the county health insurance package.
